Caleb's Character

Caleb was 85 years old.
His name means *dog*.

Character defines what type of person you are before others and ultimately before God.

1. Character is **forged** by your beliefs/convictions (Numbers 14:24).
2. Character is **formed** by your companions (Joshua and Moses).
How are your companions influencing you?
Do they lure you into the wrong things (i.e. books, music, relationships, worldly lust)?
3. Character is **firmed up** by consistently making right decisions.
